

Fred Nicholas Named New Sports Editor

The resignation of Arnold Lieberman, sports editor of the Daily Trojan, was announced last night by Stanley M. Gortikov, editor-in-chief who at the same time named Fred Nicholas, a junior, to replace him.

Lieberman, who is assistant to Al Wesson, director of athletic news at SC, was appointed sports editor last June and had worked on the Trojan in that capacity for the past month.

He found himself unable to continue in both jobs, however, and submitted his resignation last week. His sports column, "Write On," will still appear on the sports page, although he will take a "vacation" this week. The next column is scheduled for Monday, October 28.

Nicholas has worked on the Daily Trojan for the past two years, and has devoted much time to sports staff activities.
